



"It is time for confession"

How to Make a Good Confession

Follow these 5 steps

1. Examine your conscience and list out the sins committed against God, others and yourself since your last confession.
2. Be sincerely sorry for your sins, and reconcile with God, others and self.
3. Take a strong decision not to repeat these sins again.
4. Make it a Sacrament by confessing your list of sins to a priest and receiving the grace through the Church.



Procedure in the Confessional

You say: "Bless me, Father, for I have sinned. It has been - (state the length of time) – since my last confession. These are my sins."

Then tell your sins and the number of times committed. When you have finished telling your sins, you should say: "For these and all the sins of my past, I am truly sorry."

Priest gives you an advice and absolution.

You say, 'An Act of Contrition'

5. As you come out of the confessional, spend few minutes in the Church in silence doing the penance priest assigned and giving thanks to God for this wonderful gift.

Enjoy the freedom of the children of God.

An Act of Contrition: *"My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In his name, my God, have mercy."*

There are two kinds of sin: mortal and venial.

Catechism [1855] "Mortal Sin destroys charity in the heart of man ...; it turns man away from God."

Mortal sin is a horrible offense against God, so horrible that it destroys the life of grace in the soul. Three simultaneous conditions must be fulfilled for a mortal sin: (1) the act must be something very serious; (2) the person must have sufficient understanding of what is being done; (3) the person must have sufficient freedom of the will.

Catechism[1863] Venial sin weakens charity... Deliberate and unrepented venial sin disposes us little by little to commit mortal sin.

For us too, it is time for confession, all blessings

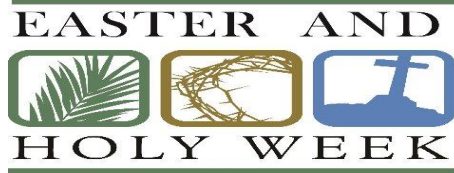

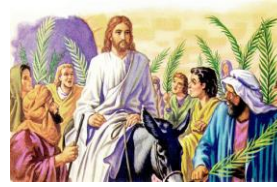
