

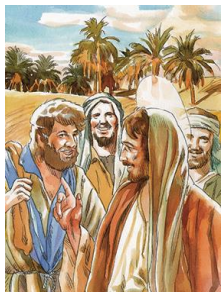

### Did you know....?

The Holy See (in Latin: Sancta Sedes) is the Catholic diocese of Rome. The bishop of this diocese is commonly known as the Pope. Although all diocesan sees are holy, the term "Holy See" is used to refer to the See of Rome, as the central government of the Catholic Church, whose head is the Pope. Although commonly referred to as "the Vatican" the Holy See is a distinct entity, dating back to the times of early Christianity, while Vatican City, as a state, came into existence only in 1929. It can be said that the Holy See operates from Vatican City.
