The Archdiocese of Toronto is one of the most diverse dioceses in the world. Each week mass is celebrated in more than 30 languages.

The Archdiocese has 255 parishes, 4 missions, 800 priests and 1.9 million Catholics and covers an area of about 13,000 square kilometers stretching from Lake Ontario up to the Georgian Bay and including Toronto, the municipalities of Peel, Durham, York and Simcoe County.

The Archdiocese is led by His Grace, Archbishop Thomas Collins (since 2006), assisted by Auxiliary Bishops, Most Reverend John Boissonneau, Most Reverend William McGrattan and Most Reverend Vincent Nguyen.

The diocese of Toronto was established in 1841 and then promoted to Metropolitan Archdiocese in 1870. The main church of the archdiocese, St. Michael's Cathedral, is the church of the Archbishop, and holds his cathedra (chair).

Archbishop Collins often presides the 12:00 PM Sunday mass.

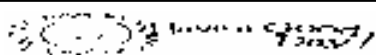
