Did you know that.....

On November the 1st we celebrate the Solemnity of All Saints. On this day we honour all the saints, known and unknown, i.e. those who are in Heaven and see God. We also look to these saints as models for our own lives, and ask their intercession in prayer to God in solving various problems we face.

On November the 2nd we celebrate All Souls Day, officially called the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed. On this day we pray for those who have passed away, but who still need purification, or to put it another way, have not yet learned to love unconditionally, and are in a state of being called purgatory. It is the belief of the Church that our prayers can help these souls on their journey to Heaven.

The reason these two feasts are celebrated on two consecutive days is based on the belief of the Church that God's people exist in 3 states with a strong relationship among them, as we profess it in the Creed "...communion of Saints...".

The three states are: Those who are in Heaven (celebrated on the first day), those who are being purified (prayed for on the second day) and those who are still on Earth (those who celebrate and pray).

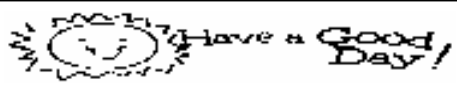

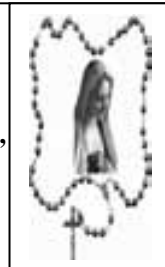
