LIFECHAIN 2010

Mother Teresa said: "Any country that accepts abortion is not teaching its people to love but to use violence to get what they want. This is why the greatest destroyer of love and peace is abortion."

Many forget that the status quo in Canada is any abortion, at any time, for any reason, at taxpayer expense. Many don't know that over a third (37.4%) of abortions are done on women who have already had one or more abortions. Many don't realize that as a Catholic Christian we need to defend life and publicly oppose abortion.

Life Chain is a simple and prayerful way to give public witness to the Truth that abortion is a violent destruction of human life. It takes only an hour and all you have to do is stand quietly with others, holding a sign with a simple message. The signs say: "Abortion kills Children", "Abortion hurts Women", and "Jesus forgives and heals". And as you stand, you can quietly pray the Rosary for the conversion of our leaders

This year Life Chain takes place on Sunday, October 3rd from 2:00 to 3:00 PM.

Did you know that......

On the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross (September 14) we celebrate the life, death and resurrection of the Lord, as represented by His Holy Cross, on which He died for us.

The feast is also called "The Triumph of the Cross".

Tradition has it that Helen, the mother of emperor Constantine, while on pilgrimage to Jerusalem in 326, discovered the cross of the Lord. That event marked the origin of the feast. The basilica of the Holy Sepulchre was built on the site of her discovery. The basilica was consecrated on September 13, 335. The date of the feast, September 14, is the date when the Cross was brought inside the Basilica, so that people could venerate it.

The feast entered into the western calendar in the seventh century, after emperor Heraclitus recovered the cross, called the True Cross, from the persians who had taken it.

Inoltre, Dio affronta le critiche per stare dalla parte del perduto: il padre affronta l'ira del figlio maggiore con amore, con pace, senza scusarsi. Gesù affronta le critiche fino a farsi calunniare, critiche che si riproducono continuamente e quasi infallibilmente. Perché tutte le volte che la Chiesa si ripropone l'immagine di Dio che cerca i perduti, nasce il disagio. E ancora, Dio si interessa anche di un solo perduto. Le parabole della pecorella perduta e della donna che fatica tanto per una sola dramma perduta, hanno del paradossale per indicare il mistero di Dio che si interessa anche di uno solo perduto, insignificante, privo di valore, da cui non c'è niente di buono da ricavare. Ciò non significa evidentemente che dobbiamo trascurare i tanti, però è un'immagine iperbolica dell'incomprensibile amore del Signore. Per questo l'etica cristiana arriva a vertici molto esigenti, che non sempre comprendiamo perché non riusciamo a farci un'idea precisa della dignità assoluta dell'uomo in ogni fase e condizione della sua vita (da Perché Gesù parlava in parabole, EDB-EMI 1985, pp. 125ss).

FIRST COMMUNION REGISTRATION


